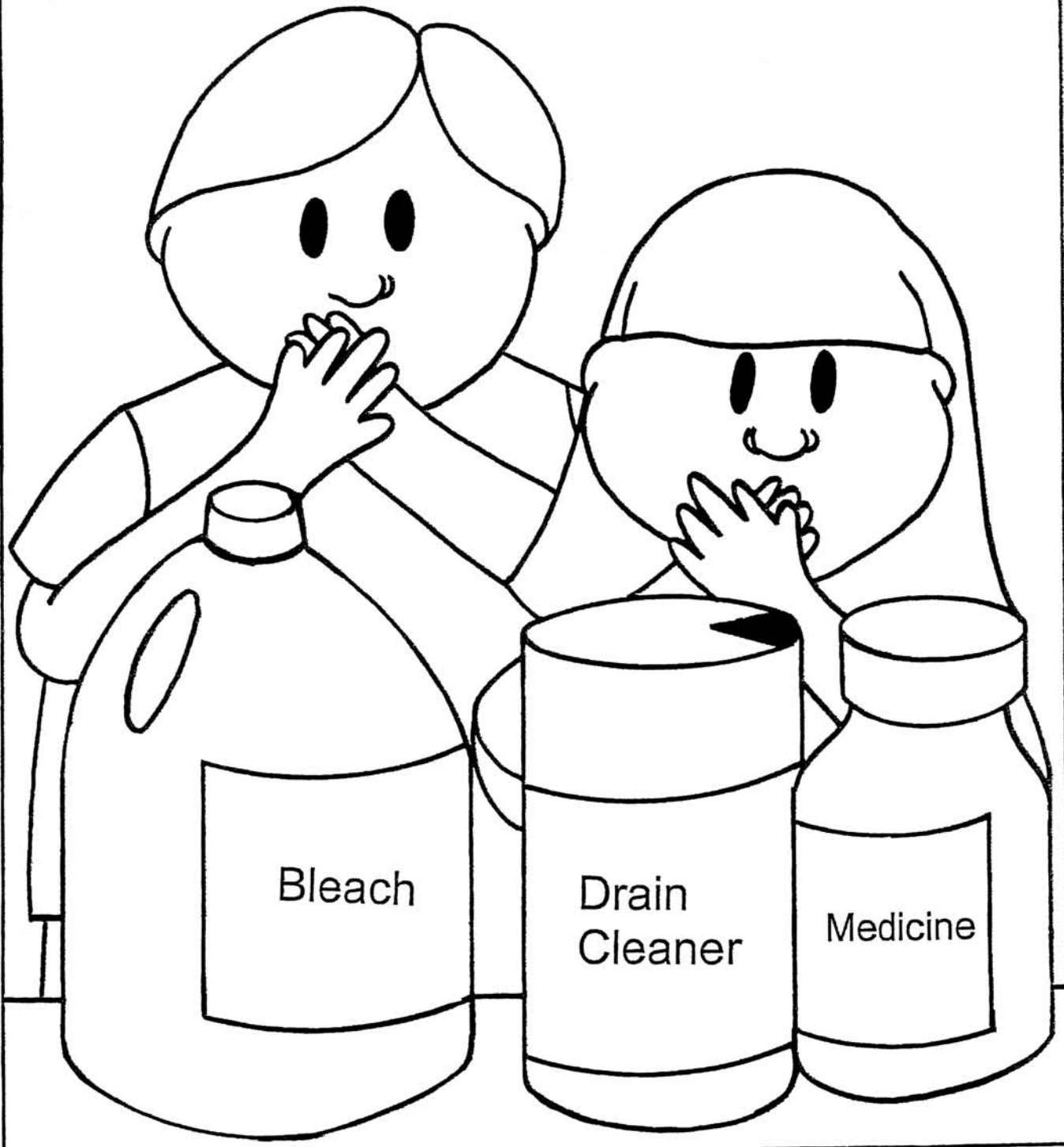
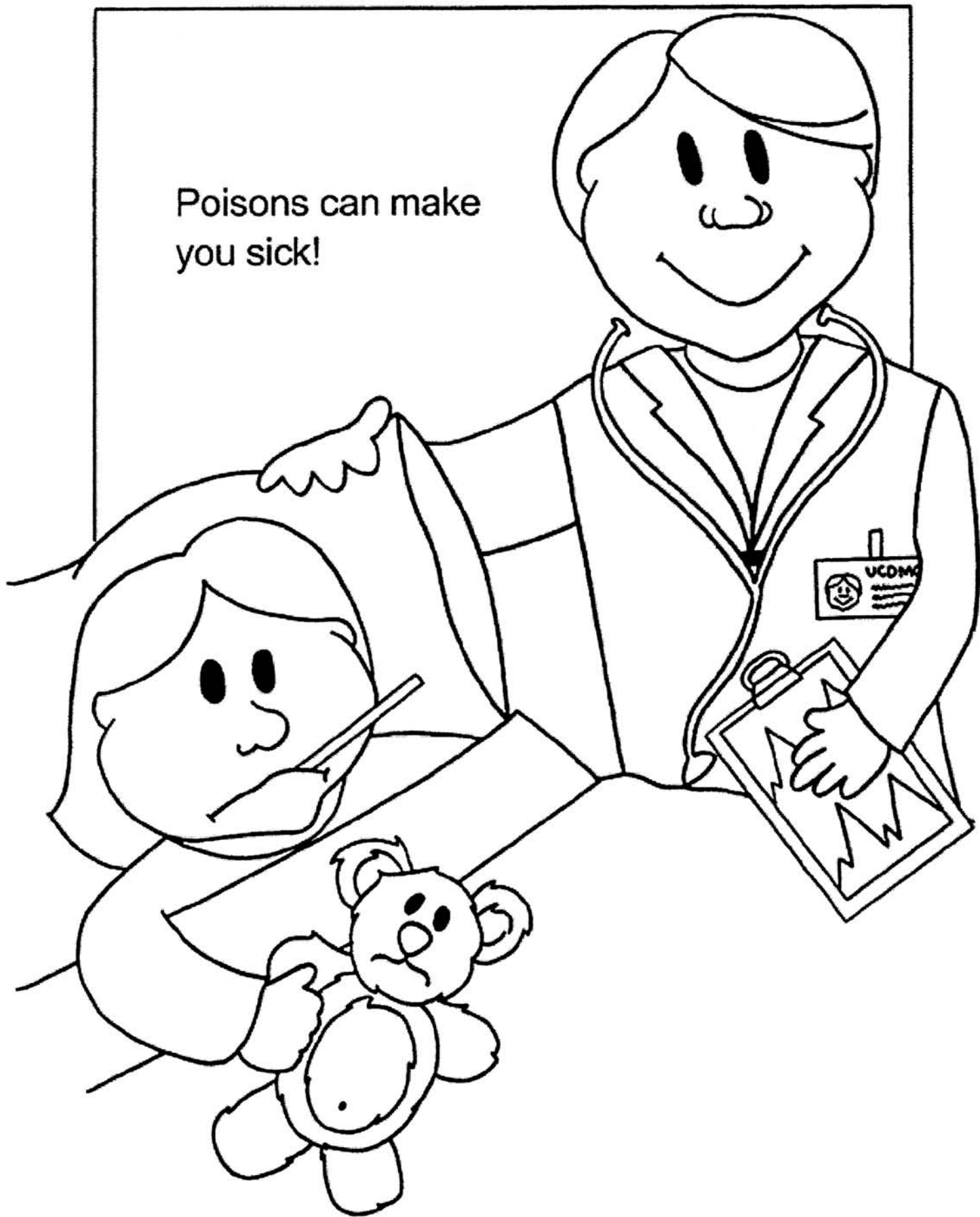


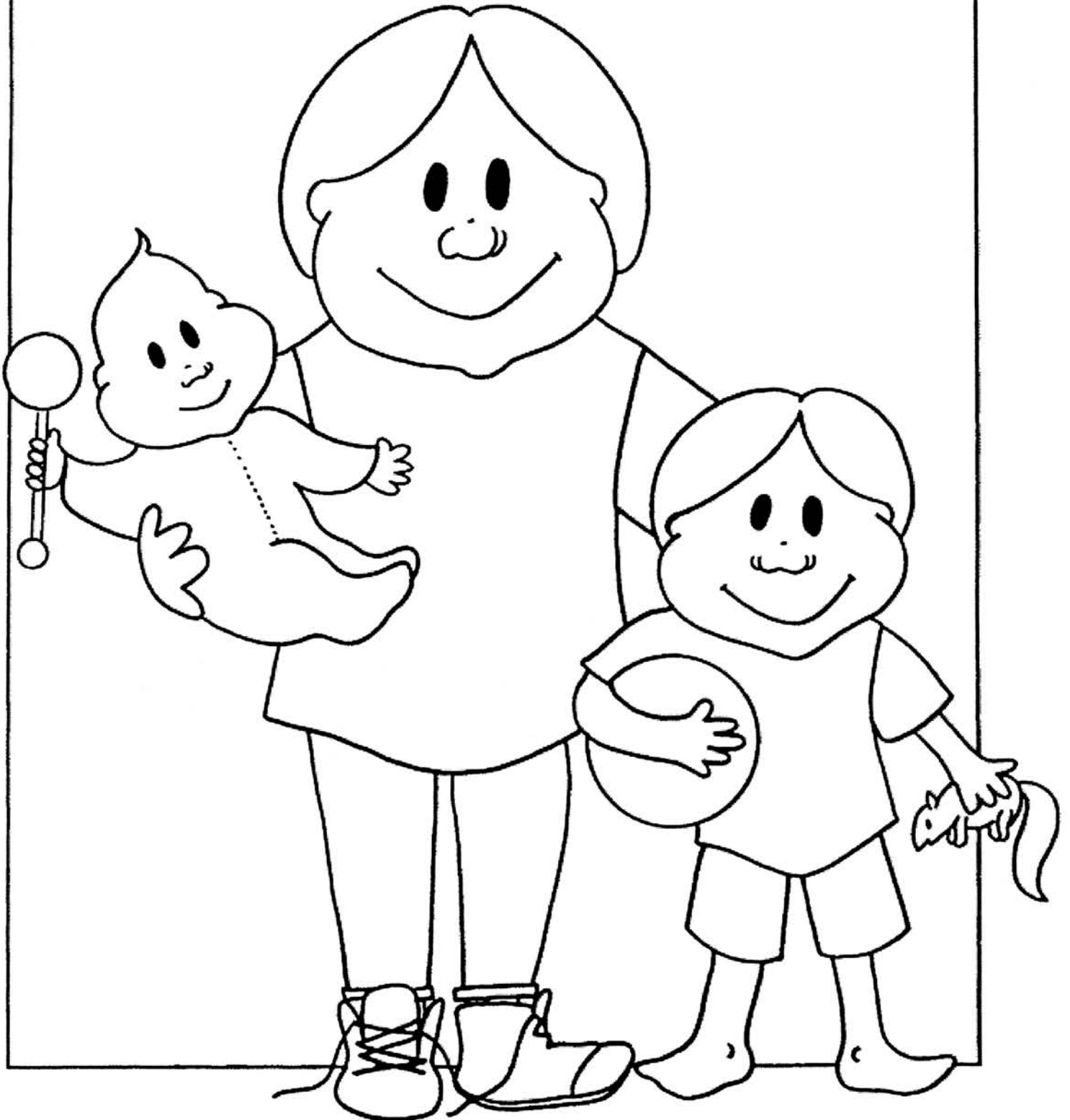
# Poison Safety Coloring Book

you sick!



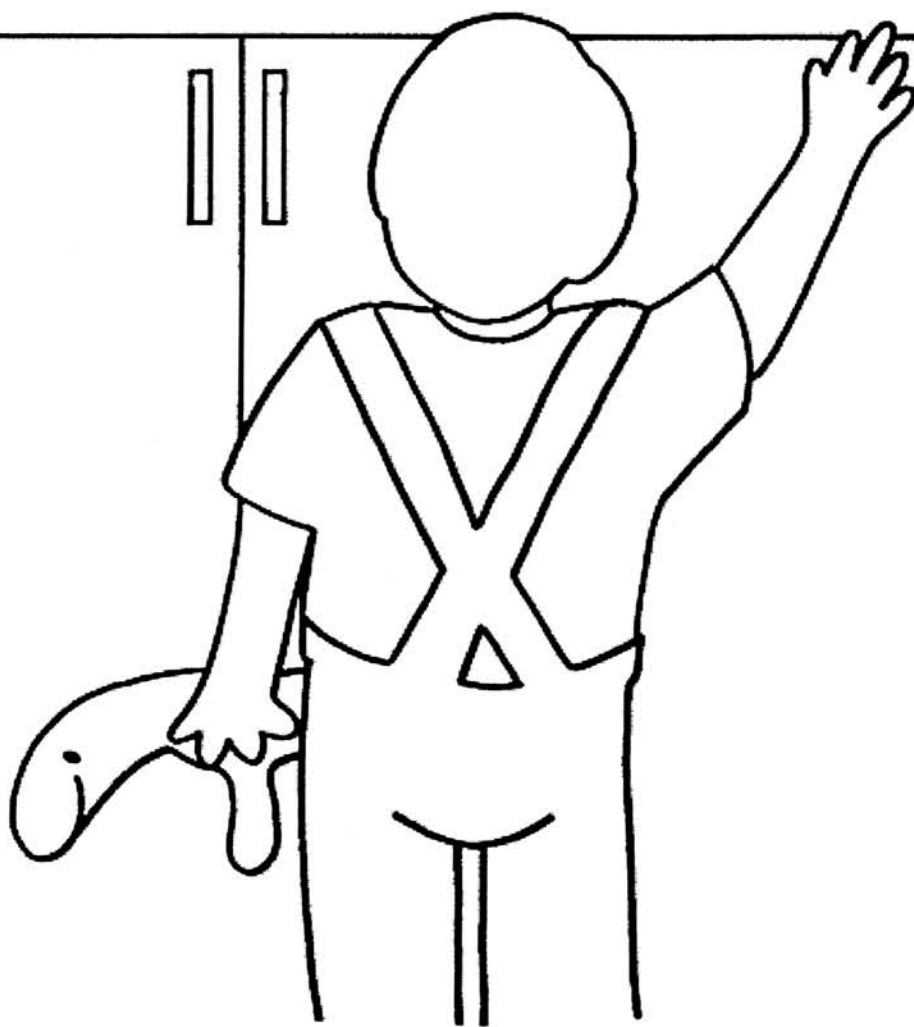
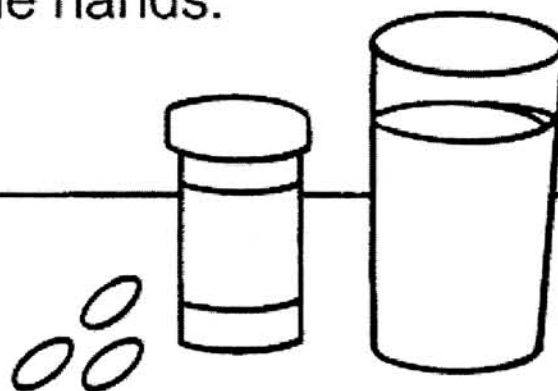
Sometimes instead of going out to play,

brother or sister.



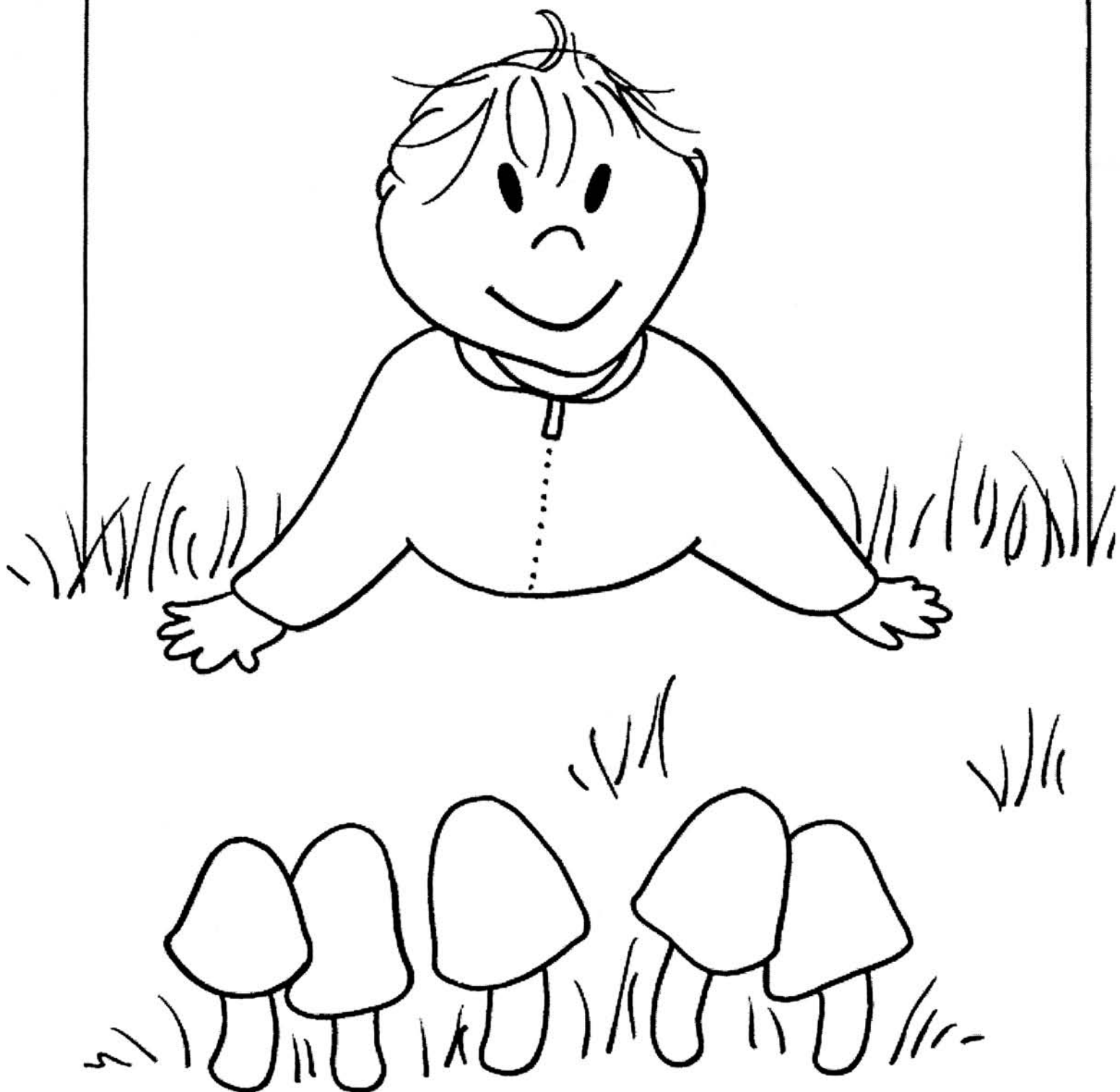
Babies can't read, so dangerous  
cleaners must be kept out of reach!



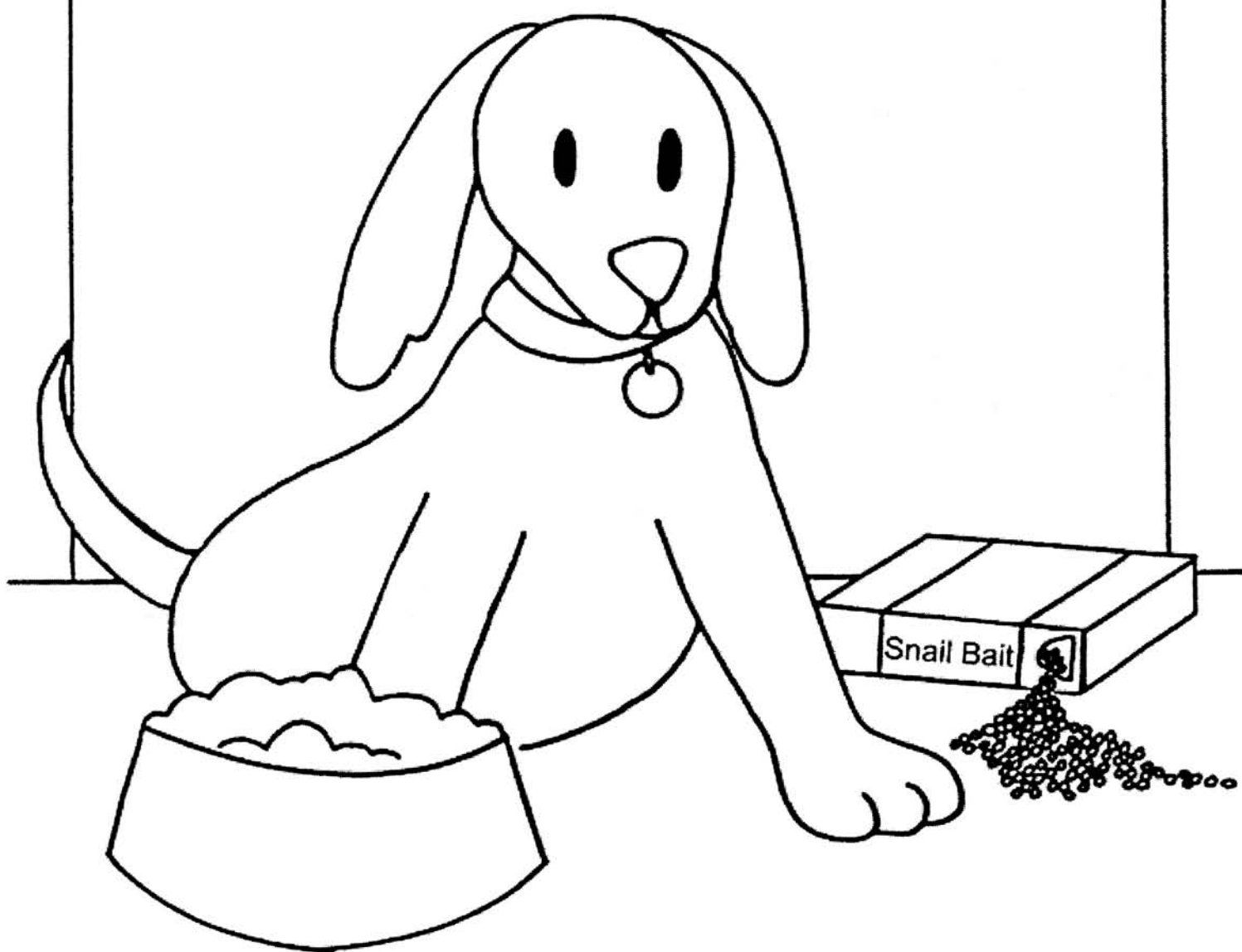
Little children can't tell the difference between medicine and candy. All medicines, even vitamins, should be locked up, safe from little hands.



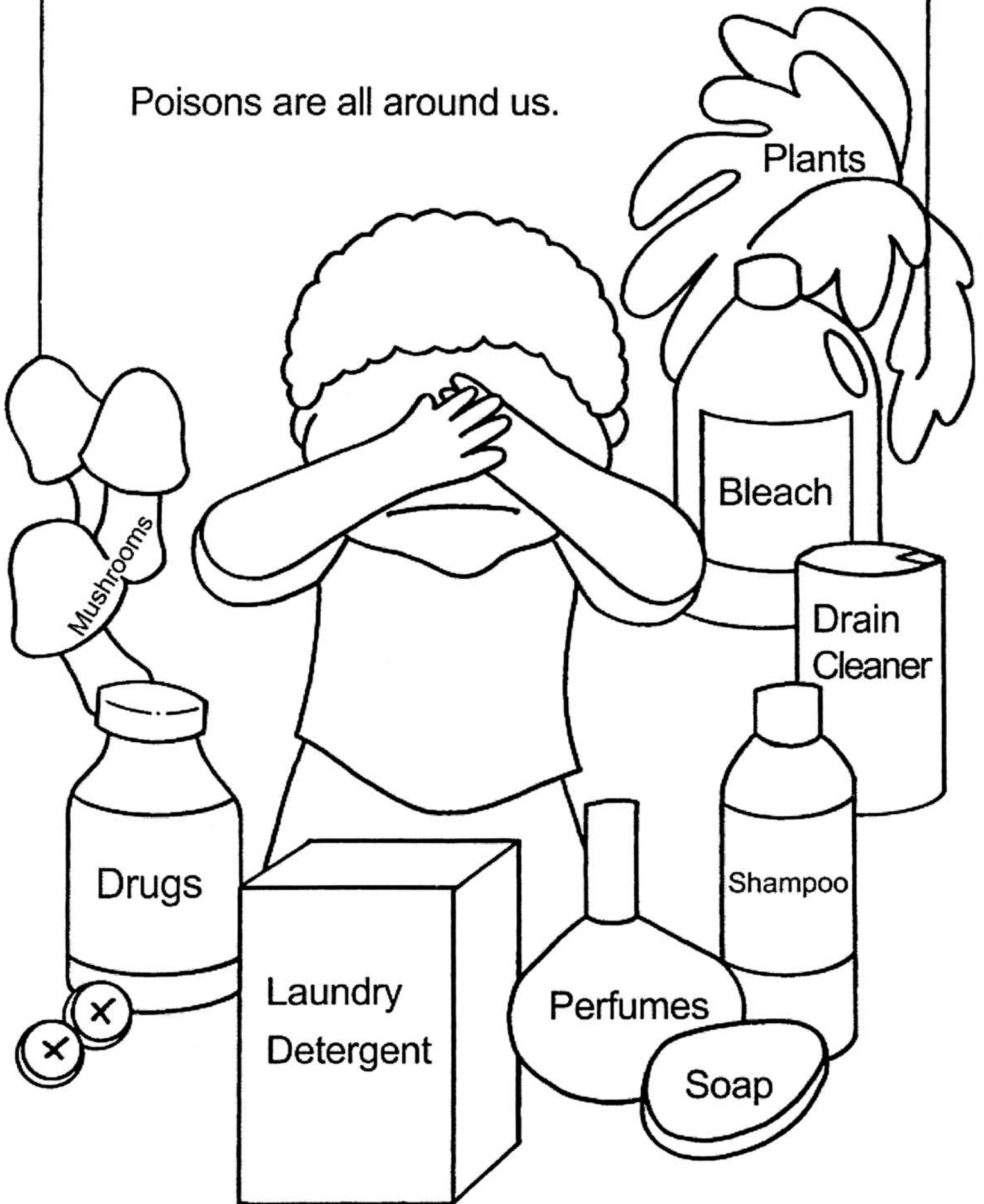
Mushrooms, berries and outdoor plants can be very dangerous. Make sure little children don't eat them.

Poisons are all around us.





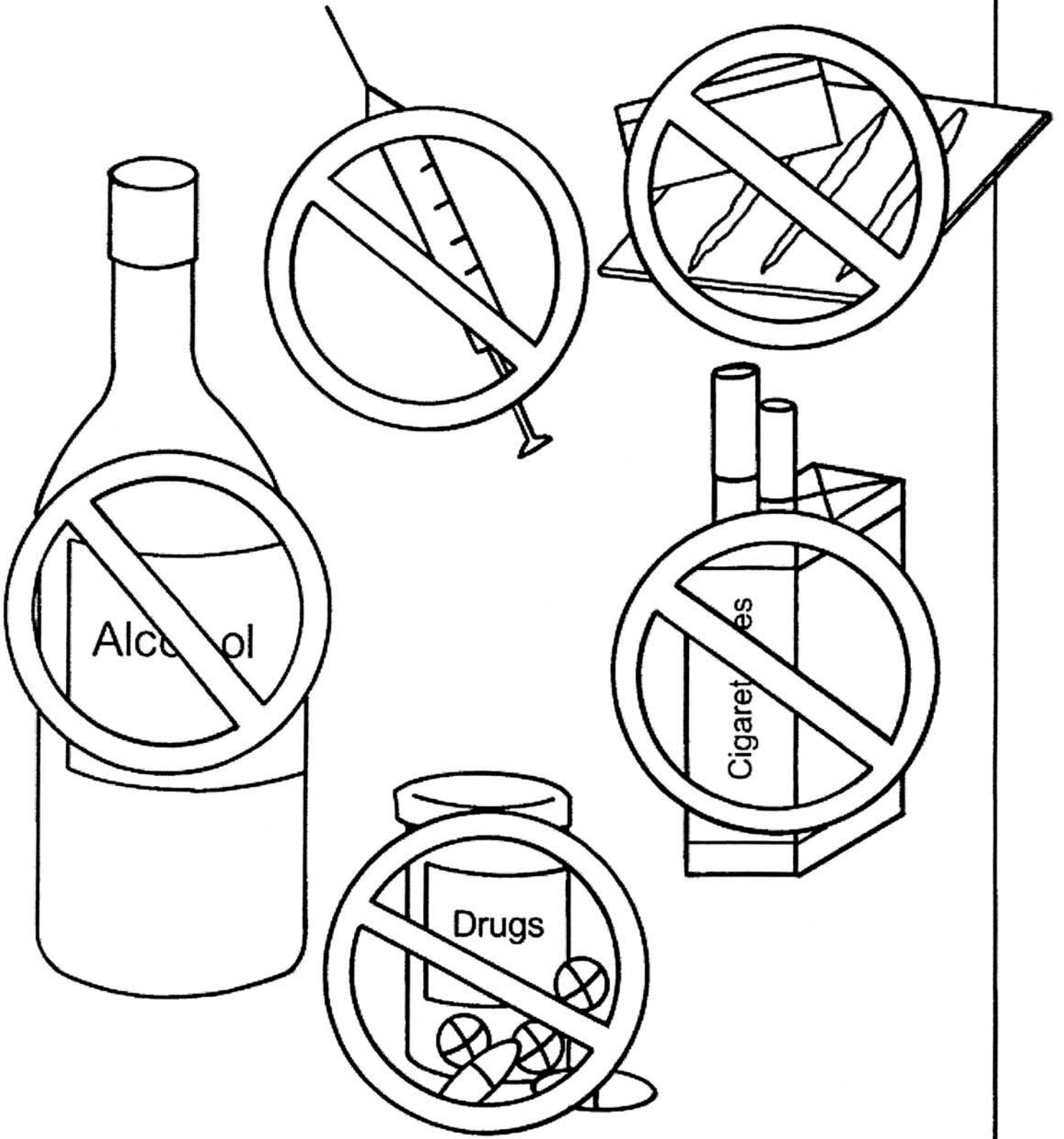
When little children find something pretty  
or new, they put it in their mouths.



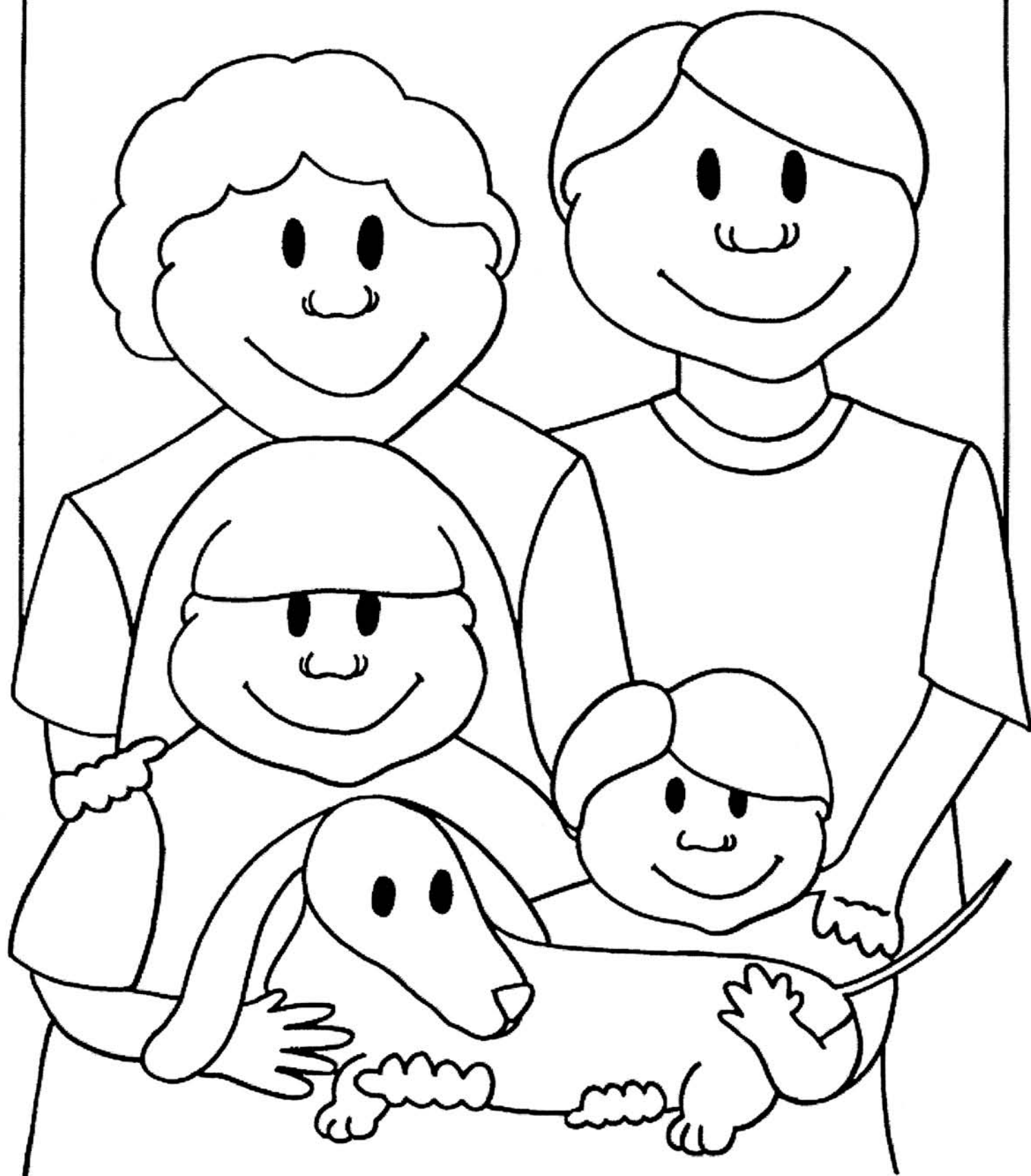
When you are outside, watch out for bites and stings.

safe for our family and pets!



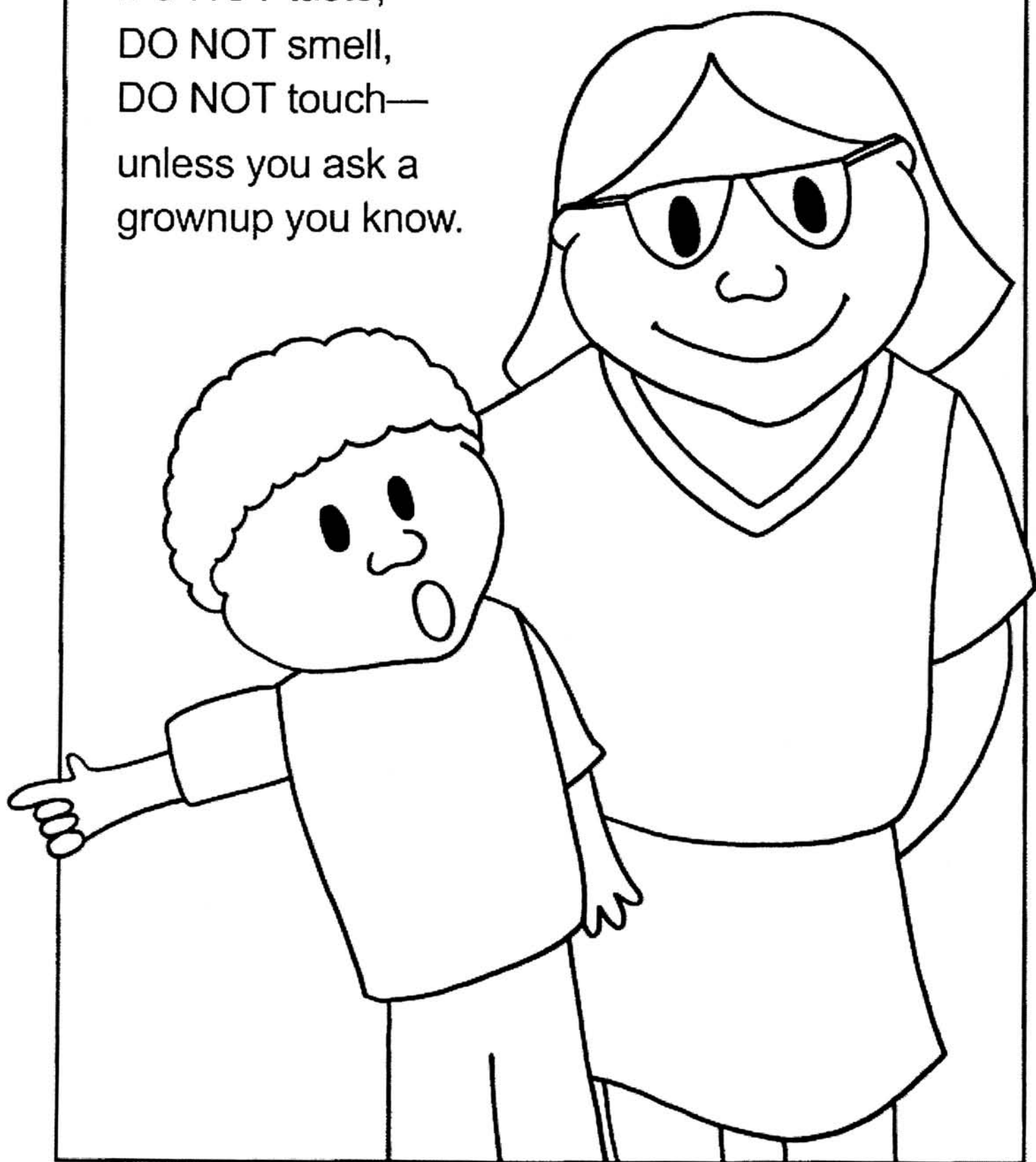
