First Aid for Poisoning

The Iowa Poison Control Center is here to help if someone swallows or comes in contact with something that might be poisonous. Don't wait for symptoms to develop. Contact Poison Control immediately! **Before you contact us**, there are first aid measures that make a difference if accomplished within seconds to minutes of the poison exposure. Be familiar with these steps.

Has the person collapsed, stopped breathing, had a seizure, or cannot be awakened?

o Call **911** or local emergency number right away.

Swallowed the wrong medicine or too much medicine?

Call 1-800-222-1222 for Poison Help.

Swallowed something that is not food or medicine?

- o Drink a small amount (1-2 ounces) of milk or water.
- o Call **1-800-222-1222** for Poison Help.

Poison or chemical in the eyes?

- Remove contact lenses and rinse eyes with tepid, running water for at least 15 to 20 minutes.
- o Call 1-800-222-1222 for Poison Help.

Poison or chemical on the skin?

- Take off any clothing that the poison touched.
- Rinse skin with tepid, running water for 15 minutes.
- Call 1-800-222-1222 for Poison Help.

Inhaled poison fumes?

- Get to fresh air right away.
- Call 1-800-222-1222 for Poison Help.

Be prepared for a poisoning emergency. Text the word "poison" to 797979 to download the poison control's contact information into your mobile phone.
